Funding Hearing:

The Neighborhood Complete Streets Commission considered the following four projects (for additional details, refer to associated Funding Hearing Booklet, presentation slides, and video recording, all posted on the NCSC webpage):

- South Irving Street Michelle Stafford and Antonette Isherwood presented on this street improvement project to install a complete sidewalk on the west side of the street, between 6th Street South and 7th Street South, in the Arlington Heights neighborhood, at an estimated cost of \$666,000.
 MOTION: That the Neighborhood Complete Streets Commission recommend approval of the South Irving Street capital project by the Arlington County Board. (APPROVED through unanimous consent)
- O 28th Street South Michelle Stafford and Jiong Lin presented on this street improvement project to install enhanced transit stops and pedestrian crossings at three locations, between South Meade Street and 26th Street South, in the Long Branch Creek neighborhood, at an estimated cost of \$880,500. MOTION: That the Neighborhood Complete Streets Commission recommend approval of the 28th Street South capital project by the Arlington County Board. (APPROVED through unanimous consent)
- North Fairfax Drive Michelle Stafford and Akram Ahmed presented on this street improvement project to install enhanced pedestrian crossings at two locations, between Arlington Boulevard and North Barton Street, in the Clarendon-Courthouse neighborhood, at an estimated cost of \$90,000.

- MOTION: That the Neighborhood Complete Streets Commission recommend approval of the North Fairfax Drive capital project by the Arlington County Board. (APPROVED through unanimous consent)
- 9th Street South Michelle Stafford and Akram Ahmed presented on this accessibility improvement project to install an accessible driveway apron/sidewalk at the AT&T building access lane, mid-block between Walter Reed Drive and South Highland Street, in the Arlington Heights neighborhood, at an estimated cost of \$30,500.
 MOTION: That the Neighborhood Complete Streets Commission recommend approval of the 9th Street South capital project by the Arlington County Board.
