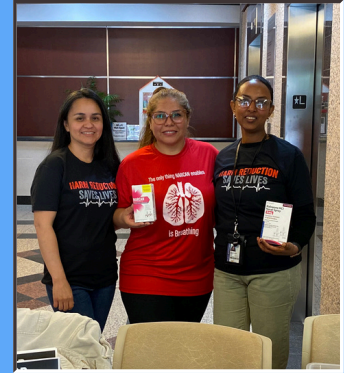

- Volunteer hours: 188

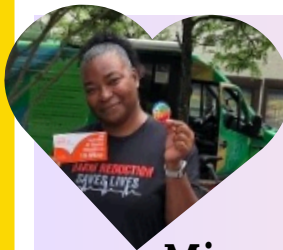


# THANK YOU
