

2023 Intermediate State Tournament Hosts: District 4 & Arlington, VA



Location: Gunston Park



Gunston Park

- 1401 28th St SArlington VA 22206
- Fully Turfed Diamond Field.
- Batting Cage.
- Lighted until at least 11 PM.
- Attached to a Community Center and Middle School, as well as a turfed "Bubble"/indoor facility.
- Two adjacent rectangular fields: one grass, one turf.
- Basketball courts, tennis courts, playgrounds for siblings.
- Street parking plus a full lot.
- Proximity to hotels, restaurants, shopping, etc.

Gunston Park - Issues?

- 1. 280' Fences SOLUTION: ALL will procure temporary fencing for at least 225' game play.
- 2. Infield cutout mimics dirt, convertible to 60', 70', and 90' basepaths with painted markings for bases.
 - SOLUTION: ALL will explore temporarily painting over 46/60 and 60/90 markers.
- 3. Turf can get very, very, very hot during the day in July. SOLUTION: ALL will provide fans, water, transportation, and on-site personnel dedicated to player/volunteer/spectator health and well-being.
- 4. Portable Mound is multiple pieces. SOLUTION: ALL will confirm legality, leave in place for the entire weekend.
- 5. Batting cage space is limited; doubles as bullpen. SOLUTION(S): ALL will rope off bullpens beyond the temporary fencing, add portable mounds down the left and right field lines. Games should be staggered to allow cage time that will not distract from on-field play (no BP during games). Alternatively / additionally, nearby fields and cages can be provided for pregame batting practice.
- 6. Bases are slippery when wet. SOLUTION: Bases need to be replaced anyway. Explore quality alternatives.

Gunston Park - Perks!

- 1. We envision an area in the outfield beyond the temporary fencing that will mimic "Home Run Hill" at Howard J Lamade Stadium in Williamsport.
- 2. In addition to seating near dugouts, a left-field gate will provide access to outfield seating for parents and fans.
- 3. ALL will set up concessions and food trucks in right field foul territory shade.


