

- Implementation of the PSMP
 - DPR Initiating the 2nd Phase of the Zoning Study related to public spaces
- Will focus on adding a use permit option for the County Board to consider case-by-case modifications of zoning laws for public spaces to enable more flexibility for reduced setback, increased height, parking, and signage.
 - Change will allow for more flexibility
 - Preserving natural environment
 - Building in urban spaces
