Al-Anon is a mutual support program for people whose lives have been affected by someone else's drinking\*\*. By sharing common experiences and applying the Al-Anon principles, families and friends of alcoholics can bring positive changes to their individual situations, whether or not the alcoholic admits the existence of a drinking problem or seeks help.

Question: My friend/loved one is a drug addict. Can I go to an Al-Anon meeting?

Answer: The primary purpose of Al-Anon is to provide support to the friends and families of alcoholics. In a recent membership survey 35% of our members said they joined our program because of a loved one's drug addiction and that their lives had improved since attending meetings. You are also welcome to try Al-Anon meetings, then decide if the Al-Anon program might be helpful to you.
