2022 HIGHLIGHTS!

Thanks to all of our AMAZING volunteers AARI:

- Hosted 24 Tabling events and interacted with close to 2,000 people at those events
- Facilitated 13 presentations with over 500 attendees
- Dispensed **1,928** boxes of Naloxone & **3,532** Fentanyl Test strips
- Distributed **1,315** Medication Deactivation Bags
- Incorporated 24/7 access to Naloxone and Fentanyl test strips at the the Crisis Intervention Center
- Added AFAC & APS as community dispensers for medication deactivation bags
- Provided 104 Lock Boxes to community members
- Included an online harm reduction request form to the AARI website
- Installed opioid overdose emergency boxes in public access locations at each library branch
- Rolled out **Medication Safety** curriculum through all of APS **Read the PSA here!**
- Hosted a Candlelight vigil for International Overdose Awareness Day which was widely attended by community members & elected officials










HARM REDUCTION SAVES LIVES!
