FAAC Opinion FAAC believes that AED is working in a challenging environment. In light of COVID, businesses are struggling and tax receipts are down. AED's charge of attracting and retaining businesses, while maintaining a strong commitment to arts and equity is important. Financing from the Transit Occupancy Tax (TOT) has dropped precipitously, putting funding for ACVS at peril. It is important for ACVS, as well as AED, continue to be funded with sufficient funding.
