Future Considerations

FAAC supports the continued funding and implementation of the Kelly Day schedule. Should funds become available, FAAC would support filling frozen positions. However, the department should evaluate whether certain functions can be better performed by civilian as opposed to uniformed personnel. Both efforts should help with overtime expenses and reduce diversion to other emergency management efforts (911 calls). FAAC will continue to evaluate the diversity and inclusion efforts already pursued by the Fire Department over the past several years and renewed efforts on data collection and analysis. FAAC supports efforts to recruit from applicants residing in Arlington County.
