

## **Swing Space Project Plan**



# Swing Space is defined as a facility that can be used by a school while its building is undergoing extensive renovations.

- Ideally, swing space would be used to relocate several schools one after the other and which may become a permanent school when no longer needed for temporary relocations.
- In the past, we had the Wilson School, the Reed School and even a relocatable village (Abingdon) to accommodate students during construction.
- APS has no dedicated swing space at present.



**Introduction to Swing Space** 

FY 2025-34 CIP directs APS to:

- Prioritize the renovations of existing APS school facilities using the framework in the CIP approved June 23, 2022.
- Identifying and explore all options for elementary school swing space by Spring 2023 to support the renovation projects targeted to begin Fall 2026.
- Note All options will be evaluated in the 2023 AFSAP

### Swing Space Possibilities: Find new spaces

#### **APS property**

- Repurpose existing elementary school, redrawing boundaries
- Repurpose the Washington-Liberty Annex, when the new ACC building opens
- Repurpose Syphax building
- Place ES students in a MS with open capacity
- Other

#### **Non-APS property**

- Repurpose a community center
  (Arlington Mill, Aurora Hills, Fairlington, Madison Manor, Walter Reed)
- Repurpose another County facility
- Other County Alternatives:
  - Green field (parkland? Adjacent to a school?)
  - Carlin Springs Urgent Care site,Buck property
- Letter from County Manager

### Additional Swing Space Possibilities

# Ideas based on Instructional Changes

- Two-Shift days (doubles capacity of single building)
- 4-quarter "year-round" multi-track building use (increases capacity 25%)
- Create upper and lower ES; Divide a School across two non-school facilities for 1-2 years
- Divide a school temporarily across neighboring schools (by geography or moving entire grade cohorts)

#### Other

- Rent Office Space
- YMCA
- Create a temporary Relocatable
  Village on any available land (APS,
  County or private)
- Find a location outside the County
- Rent other private facility (Westover Baptist Church)
