FAAC recognizes the challenges that the Sheriff's Office has faced over the past year in addressing COVID-19 and racial justice. FAAC is also appreciative of the Sheriff's efforts over the past year to adapt operations, including virtualizing transactions and eliminating overtime costs of previous rollcall requirements. Given the overall budget challenges faced by the county in the current fiscal environment, FAAC is supportive of the proposed reduction of 3.0 percent.
