Outdoor courts considered for pickleball include: full size tennis courts on County owned parkland, full-size basketball courts on County owned parkland and associated with full-time staffed community centers.

Certain courts were removed from consideration to avoid conflict with Arlington Public School (APS) scholastic programs. The following outdoor tennis and basketball courts were removed from consideration: Bluemont Park, Charles Drew Community Center, Greenbrier Park, Gunston Community Center and Park, Hoffman Boston Elementary School/Carver Community Center, Kenmore Middle School, Langston High School, Quincy Park, Stratford Park, Thomas Jefferson Community Center and Park, Wakefield High School, Williamsburg Middle School, and Yorktown High School.

Bluemont Park tennis courts were removed because it is the County's designated outdoor tennis complex, which provides the highest level of facilities for tennis matches and competitions (PSMP, page 67-68).

Each site that meets a criterion will get one point. This is consistent with the PSMP Athletic Fields and Synthetic Turf Conversion table. (PSMP, page 204).

Points are summed and the table is ordered from highest to lowest score, then alphabetically by park name.

^{**} Distance is measured using a linear 1 mile distance. Courts currently lined for pickleball received a point to not penalize them for consideration when assessing for permanent pickleball facility.
