March

AARI volunteers were busy in the community during National Drug and Alcohol Facts Week, leading 2 presentations and tabling 6 events. Part of our outreach that week included our **1st** Mega Mart outreach.

We wrapped up the quarter with our **1st** Rosslyn Narcan Pop-Up event.

- Xylazine test strips (began in November): 17
- Medication deactivation bags: 156
