- 410 medication deactivation bags distributed.
- 1,232 fentanyl test strips distributed



AARI stakeholder Jenny Sexton has been hard at work for **months** creating curriculum for Arlington Public Schools to address misuse of medications by teens.

The misuse of medications can cause life-threatening consequences, including overdose, heart attack, stroke, and death. When using prescription medications inappropriately, there is also an increased risk of teens engaging in the use of other substances, such as alcohol or marijuana.

Jenny's curriculum will be implemented by Health and PE teachers during the school year. Thank you Jenny for your dedication to keeping this community safe!

remembrance, awareness, education, and
resources about drug overdose. At least 65
people gathered at CourtHouse Plaza to
hear from loved ones impacted by overdose
as well as individuals who shared their
personal stories of recovery from addiction.
We lit candles as the names of deceased
loved ones were read aloud.

The event concluded with opportunities to learn about treatment resources, receive Naloxone training, and lots of hugs Thank you to everyone who participated in this meaningful occasion.
