

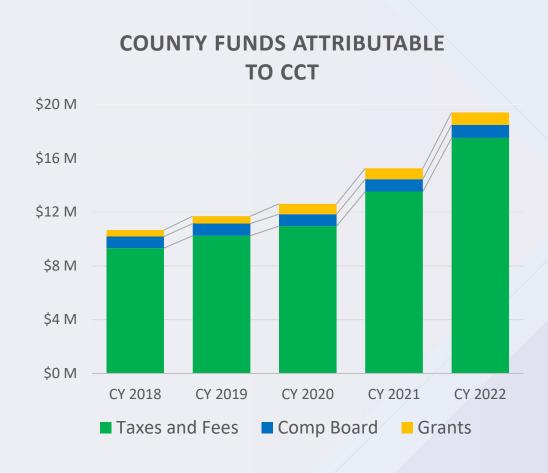
Department Overview

- Courtroom technology upgrades have been extremely successful
 - Project won interdepartmental County Manager Excellence Award with individuals from DTS
- Civil cases increased more than 32%
 - Arlington is the court of choice for some civil filers due to eFiling capabilities
- Deed recordings increased over 13%
- Criminal cases decreased over 27%

 - Technology funds from the State to reimburse localities for technology projects that have been implemented

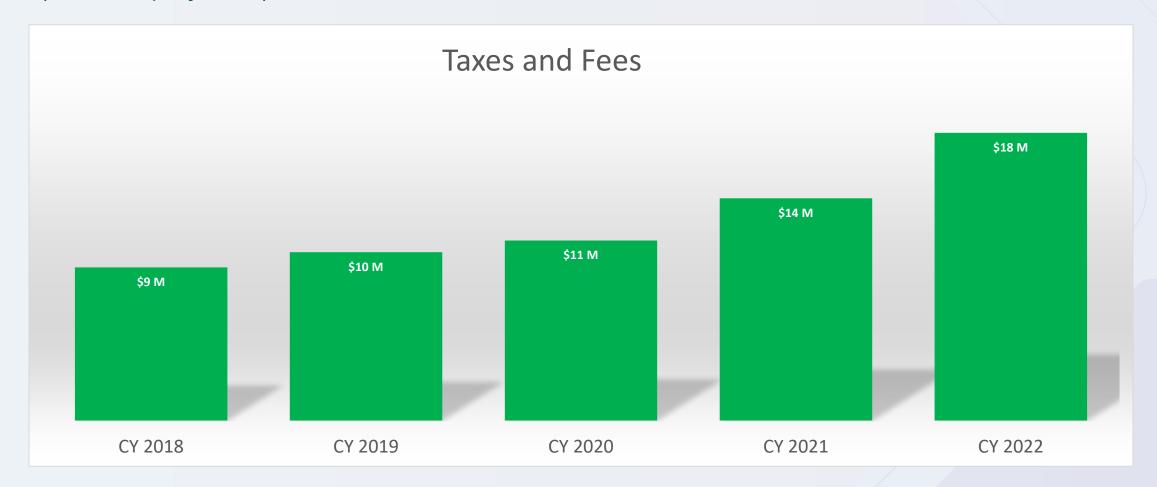




Taxes and Fees Collected from CCT Transactions

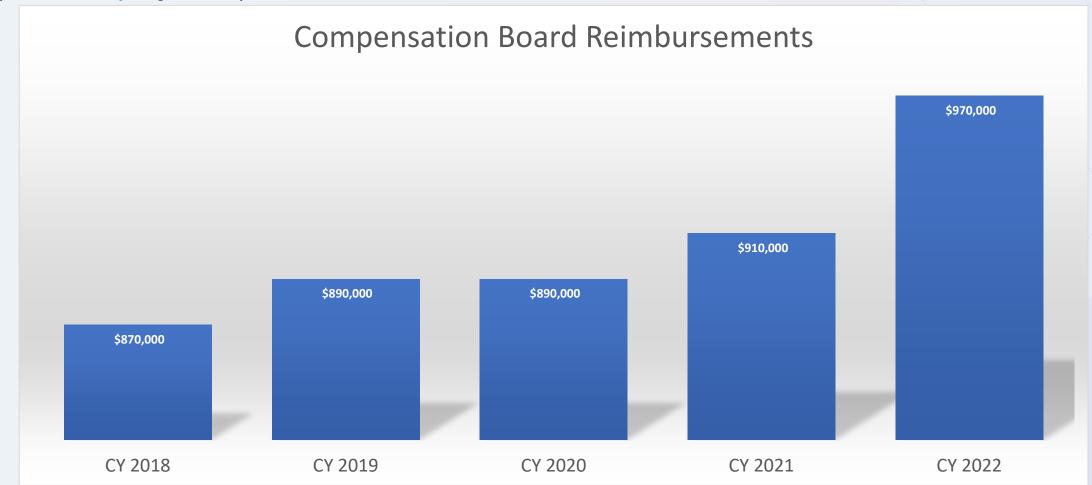
92% from Land Records

Focus on Equity

- Waiver of Credit Card Fees for Criminal Defendant's paying costs for fines online
- Spanish Language staff in all sections of the office (Land Records, Criminal, Civil, Probate). Other staff speaks and can translate in Amharic, Mongolian, and Portuguese.
- Online fillable PDF (English and Spanish) forms created by Arlington Clerk's Office for Name Change and Marriage License applications
- Information provided for criminal defendants on performing community services in lieu of court costs/fines
- Blank Paper Precipe Forms for self represented litigants
- Divorce packet with sample pleadings for self represented litigants
- Handouts directing self represented litigants to State Legal Self-Help website

- Requesting an additional FTE in Civil Division to handle the 33% increase in cases
 - This FTE is not reflected in the proposed budget
 - Revenue increases will offset the FTE cost

Key Budget Considerations

- Civil filings and land records transactions are up
- Taxes collected, compensation board reimbursements, grants and fees from the state are also up
- CCT needs a 1.0 FTE to keep up with the increasing filings in the civil division
 - Additional funds from the State will help offset the costs of adding the FTE for the civil division
