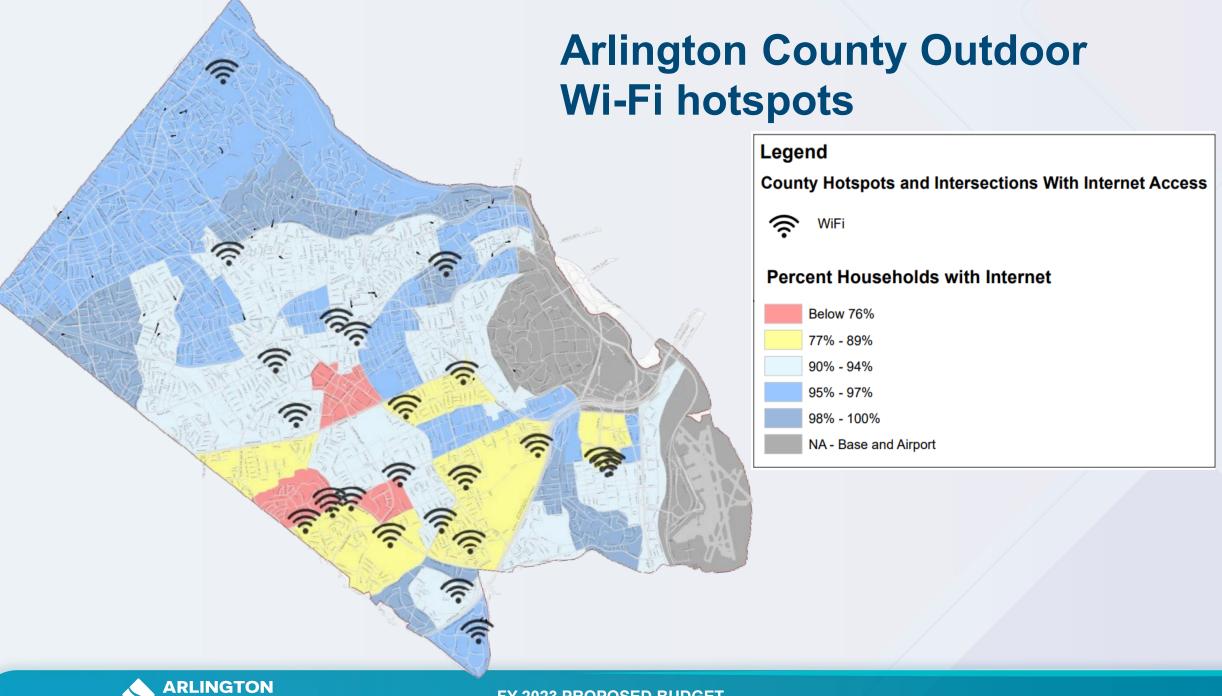


## Focus on Equity
