Department Overview


- Civil and criminal cases remained relatively steady.
- Land transactions decreased again.
- New cloud-based Land Records system funded by CIP is projected for deployment 2Q 2024.

Focus on Equity

- Free access to case information system to view upcoming hearing dates and documents filed.
- Courtroom technology upgrades provide more flexibility and easier access to justice.
- Continue to waive credit card fees for defendants paying fines and costs online.
- Multi-lingual staff in the office including Spanish, Amharic, and Korean.
- Handouts and tools to direct self represented litigants to local and state legal self-help resources.



Summary of Proposed Changes

- Personnel increases due to salary increases and adjustments resulting from recent job family studies.
- Non-personnel decreases due to proposed budget reductions, offset by contractual increases and statutory increase in juror compensation.



Detail of Proposed Reductions

Reduce expenditures related to training, data processing, operating equipment, and equipment repair.

Service Impacts

•These reductions will limit technology trainings and certifications for staff, reduce the number of historical records that are scanned and digitally accessible to constituents, and require the Clerk's office to request additional funding for any system upgrades as well as service and repair of equipment.

Budget Impact

Change: -\$110,188



Key Budget Considerations

- New land records system is a cloud-based solution
 - Will improve access to data and documents
 - Lower upfront costs but annual maintenance costs are higher
- Opportunity to scan paper case files
 - Improve public access
 - Protect against degradation
 - Free up space on the 6th and 11th floors of the courthouse
