JFAC discussed edits to the document, refining draft recommendations regarding the Superintendent's proposals for swing space and the Career Center site. Additional JFAC recommendations on the Pre-CIP Report will be discussed following the release of the forthcoming Long-Range Plan to Renovate Existing School Facilities.
