### Neighborhood Complete Streets Commission Meeting Minutes

#### Monday, October 18, 2021 Online Meeting

- Approval of Minutes: Minutes from the July 2021 meeting approved unanimously with amendments.

#### • Guest Speaker: Kyle Kling, Capital Project Manager, DES

Kyle presented updates to the active NCS capital projects (see attached).

- 13<sup>th</sup> Street S has reached 100% design and has received all permanent easements, with a delayed project construction to early 2022. The project is expected to come in approximately \$40,000 over the cost estimated at the Funding Hearing in July 2020. The on-call contractor scheduled for construction of this project is A & M.
- 7<sup>th</sup> Road S has reached 100% design, is partially constructed, with construction scheduled for the remaining intersection at 7<sup>th</sup> Road S & S Florida Street in late November, 2021. The project is approximately \$203,000 below the cost estimated at the Funding Hearing in July 2020, largely due to utilization/availability of county resources for construction.
- Discussion items included how to hand cost overruns and surpluses, and if detailed cost estimates and actuals can be shared at future meetings.

#### • Chair's Report:

**Street Width & Fire Code** — The Chair led a discussion about options to advance NCS projects in light of differences in the Fire Code and MTP on street width design. Options include avoidance of streets with width issues that can't conform to Fire Code, advocating to follow the MTP street width guidelines, conform to the fire code but address a smaller part of the problem to have less resistance, or a hybrid approach that seeks to find projects that conform to Fire Code in the interim only.

#### • Staff Update:

 Traffic counts have been ordered but there is still a backlog of work, and delays are expected.

## Minutes, NCSC 10/18/2021 Meeting Page 2

- Staff continues to advance 28<sup>th</sup> Street S through the preliminary design process.
   Efforts to launch public engagement are underway, though there are several vacancies on the DES Communications staff team.
- Staff continue to meet and try to advance the S Irving Street project. Meetings now involve DES and and ACFD leadership.










