### **Addictions, Corrections, and Treatment (ACT) Unit**

### **Community Corrections Alternative Program (CCAP)**

The Virginia Parole Board or a circuit court judge can order a CCAP evaluation.  
*An alternative program to incarceration sponsored by the VA DOC, giving probationers and parolees the opportunity to engage in substance use disorder treatment, education, vocational training, and employment in a structured setting in order to promote long lasting public safety. Participants must be on supervision for the duration of the program, if accepted. After successfully completing the program, they will have a recommended period of at least one year of regular supervision.*
