WHEREAS, Doreen Gentzler was raised in the Dominion Hills neighborhood of Arlington County until the age of 11; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Gentzler graduated from the Henry W. Grady College of Journalism and Mass Communication at the University of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Gentzler worked as a television news anchor in Charlotte, North Carolina; Cleveland, Ohio; Chattanooga, Tennessee; and Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, in 1989 Ms. Gentzler returned to the Washington, DC area and joined NBC4 Washington as the only female news anchor, where she quickly became a household name throughout the region; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Gentzler co-anchored the NBC4 nightly news for 33 years, working with Jim Vance for the first 28 years to turn the program into a popular and in-depth source of local, regional, national, and international news, eventually drawing in more viewers in the DC area than major cable news networks; and

WHEREAS, during Ms. Gentzler's career at NBC4, she also reported on local health and medical news, and traveled abroad to report in Bosnia, Ecuador, and from the USNS Comfort Hospital Ship; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Gentzler has become known to Arlingtonians and the Washington region as a trusted, empathetic, and passionate journalist who is dedicated to serving her community; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Gentzler maintains her connections to the Arlington community, particularly enjoying Signature Theatre in Shirlington and the W&OD bike trail;
