WHEREAS, Arlington's trees reduced 10,730,168 cubic feet/year of storm and floodwater runoff, equal to 122 Olympic-sized pools; and

WHEREAS, Arlington's trees have saved over \$1 million annually in energy costs; and

WHEREAS, students in the Arlington Public Schools system will show their commitment to the environment through ceremonies at their schools;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Matt de Ferranti, Chair of the County Board in Arlington, Virginia, do hereby proclaim Friday, April 30, 2021 as the celebration of
