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Conditions for Temporary Tents or Other Membrane Structures

	s must conform and comply with the Virginia Statewide Fire Prevention Code, § Chapter 31, Tents and
	Membrane Structures. The Fire Prevention Office will review and inspect each application/location
prior to	approval
	Greater than 120 square feet
	Less than 900 square feet
	☐ If larger than 900 square feet a permit is required
	☐ Multiple tents separated by less than 12 feet at any point shall not exceed 900 square feet
	Less than 50 occupants
	☐ More than 50 occupants a permit is required
	Regular inspections of the entire tent at regular intervals by a licensed 3 rd party
	☐ Maintain and produce inspection reports upon request of the Fire Code Official
	Not erected on buildings, balconies, or other structures
	Tents shall be anchored to withstand the elements of weather and prevent collapsing
	Certificate of flame propagation performance testing or treatment
	☐ An affidavit or affirmation shall be submitted, and a copy retained on premises on which
	the tent or air-supported structure is located
	☐ The affidavit shall attest to all the following information relative to the flame propagation
	performance criteria of the fabric:
	☐ Names and address of the owners of the tent or air-supported structure
	 Date the fabric was last treated with flame-retardant solution
	 Trade name or kind of chemical used in treatment
	□ Name of person or firm treating the material
	 Name of testing agency and test standard by which the fabric was tested
	☐ This certificate shall be filed with the Fire Prevention Office prior to approval
	☐ Combustible materials such as hay, straw or saw dust are prohibited in the tent
	☐ Smoking is prohibited under tents and shall be posted
	□ No cooking is allowed under tents or membrane structures
	☐ Portable outdoor gas-fired heating appliances regardless of condition (on, off, with cylinder,
	without cylinder, etc.) may not be used, stored, or otherwise located under the tent
	☐ Portable open flame heating devices must be at least 5 feet from the tent
	 A notice of violation will be issued if the distance is not maintained
	 Repeated violations will result in review of the tent approval and possible
	revocation
	 The evacuation of all occupants, by the Fire Prevention Office, from the
	tent for unsafe conditions, will result if propane or other noncompliant
	heaters are found violating the fire code
	ed Tents or Other Membrane Structures will be removed within 48 hours of the application expiration
date.	
Fees sh	nall be levied in accordance with the Arlington County Fire Prevention Code for operational
permit	s and/or related inspections. <u>2021 FPO Fee Schedule</u>
	Tents or Membrane Structures that require a permit will not be charged separate inspection fees
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
