## **Business Rules for TAC Accessiblity Subcommittee**

## Adopted: January 16, 2024

- The Accessibility Subcommittee will report to the Transit Advisory Committee
  on matters that require discussion or action by the full Committee. The
  Accessibility Subcommittee will provide advice and recommendations to the
  County Manager on transit related accessibility needs, challenges, facilities,
  plans and policies, fixed route service, as well as STAR and MetroAccess
  services.
- The Accessiblity Subcommittee will be made up of not more than seven members appointed by the Transit Advisory Committee. Members will be residents of Arlington County or employed in Arlington County. All members will serve at the pleasure of and can be removed from the Subcommittee by the TAC Chair with cause. Subcommittee members are expected to participate regularly and will be subject to dismissal if attendance at regular meetings falls below 50% in one calendar year. Members will be appointed to serve two-year terms. Members can be appointed at any time during the year, with the initial term ending on June 30 of the second year following the year of appointment. Members can be reappointed for additional terms.
- At the start of each fiscal year, the Accessiblity Subcommittee will designate a member to serve as Chair and Vice-Chair. The Chair and Vice-Chair will be responsible for reviewing meeting agendas, overseeing the Accessiblity Subcommittee meetings, and facilitating any official correspondence.
- Individuals who are interested in being nominated to the Accessiblity Subcommittee must submit an email to the appointed Accessiblity Subcommittee staff liaison to include their full name, email address, home address, phone number, and provide a statement of purpose for wanting to be part of the Accessiblity Subcommittee. Once this information is received, the Accessiblity Subcommittee staff liaison will submit the requested nomination to the TAC staff liaison, TAC chair, and TAC Vice Chair for consideration at the next scheduled TAC meeting. Once the Accessiblity Subcommittee reaches seven members, the Accessiblity Subcommittee staff liaison shall establish a waiting list for those interested.
- The TAC can modify the business rules to the Accessibility Subcommittee via vote at any time.
