### What is the roadway like today?

- Four vehicle lanes (some turn bays)
- Primary Transit Network (Metrobus 25B and Arlington Transit Route 75)
- 4-5' wide sidewalks with 0-2' buffer
  - Curbs and handicap ramps not compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

### What do we know about vehicle speeds?

- Posted speed limit of 30 mph with additional \$200 fine
- Extended 20 mph beacon school zone for three schools on corridor (Route 50 to 7th Place S.)
  - School zone speed limit currently enforced by ACPD speed safety camera program


### What are the challenges?

- Add a buffer zone between people walking and driving



