




Corridor Overview

- MWCOG Equity Emphasis Area








Crossing George Mason

- Pedestrian Crossings
 - 7 signalized
 - 4 unsignalized
 - 2 HAWK
- Two school slow zones
 - A School Slow Zone is a permanent 20 mile-per-hour speed limit on a neighborhood street within 600 feet of an access point to a school. Speed limit signs and pavement markings clearly define the zone.



Transit

- Major ART bus routes
- ART 45: Columbia Pike-DHS/Sequoia-Rosslyn (purple)
- ART 72: Shirlington-Ballston-Rock Spring (orange)
- ART 75: Shirlington-Ballston-VA Square (pink)



Trails and Cycling

- 8 east-west bicycle network connections
- 2 trail connections
 - W&OD Trail
 - Four Mile Run Trail
- 4 Capital Bikeshare stations



Study Intersections

- 1. Arlington Boulevard
- 2. Columbia Pike
- 3. S. Four Mile Run Drive
- 4. S. Columbus Street
- 5. S. Hamilton Street

AM/PM Peak Period Counts


- Peak Period counts capture individual vehicle movements at the five study intersections when vehicular traffic is heaviest
- Additional data collection:
 - 12-hour traffic counts at five (5) high-priority crossing locations
 - 7-day tube counts (speed, volume, class)




Average Daily Traffic

ADT from Tube Counts – collected March 2022

- Location 1: Wakefield High School
 - 17,000 vehicles per day
- Location 2: Between S. Four Mile Run and Columbia Pike
 - 12,400 vehicles per day
- Location 3: Between Columbia Pike and Arlington Blvd
 - 9,400 vehicle per day





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
