

ART Ridership Trends


- 1. Sustained year-over-year growth, 2024 almost reaching 100% recovery to 2019 ridership levels
- 2. Returning to pre-pandemic monthly travel patterns

ART Ridership Trends:


- 1. Generated roughly 100,000 additional passenger trips for the same period from 2023 to 2024 (circled in red)
- In 2023, weekend ridership averaged 5%, compared to
 6.2% in 2024 with the most growth in Saturday ridership



ART 2023-2024 Performance Review: Program Updates

Opportunities to Ride ART with Reduced Fare


- 1. Successful Fare Free Rush Promotion from October 2023 through January 2024 generated ridership growth
- 2. Student iRide Program Expansion, providing over 6,000 student passes generating growth in student population
- 3. ART's 25th Anniversary Promotion offering free trips on ART on the 25th day of every month in the 2024 Calander year
- 4. Extended service on the 41 and 45



ART 2023-2024 Performance Review:

ART On-Time Performance Trends

- 1. Jan, Feb, and March 2024 OTP averages around 74%
 - compared to 77% OTP in 2023 for the same period
- 2. Return of full ridership impacting OTP, more traffic, and construction



This graph depicts On-Time Performance (OTP) of Arlington Transit's fixed-route service as a percentage, by month. On-Time Performance is the percentage of trips that reach a timepoint on-time. A timepoint is a bus stop that is listed in the printed schedule. OTP is calculated by taking the number of timepoints on a route where the bus showed up on-time (0 minutes being early, 5 minutes being late) and dividing by the total number of timepoints on the scheduled route. Any buses that are early or more than five (>5) minutes late are not considered on-time. This metric illustrates the reliability of ART service and the operational efficiency of ART. Select all routes for systemwide or select individual routes for a route level breakdown. Select one or more calender years to explore ART's On-Time Performance over time. This data is sourced from the service provider who is responsible for tracking and reporting service performance metrics.

Student Ridership Trends

- 3 months of Metrobus access: >10,000 student trips in March 2024 on, 1. averaging 2,000 monthly growth
- 2. Estimated an average of ~12,000 student ridership on ART a month
- 3. Student ridership on transit in Arlington totaling over 20,000 trips a month or 240,000 estimated for the 2024 year between WMATA and ART

Student iRide Program 2023-2024 Performance Review: Program Updates

Student iRide Program (SIP) Expansion

- 1. In 2023, ART and Metrobus finalized the SIP agreement which began subsidized student access on select metrobus routes
- 2. In 2023 Student iRide Program provided over 6,000 student passes generating growth in student rider population



STAR Ridership Trends

- 1. 3,561 average trips for January through March 2024 (green line with "x" points) compared to 3,413 trips for the same period in 2023
- 2. 2023 Calander year experienced 43,271 trips, roughly 58% of 2019 STAR ridership (See grey arrow)




This graph depicts Trips Completed by Arlington Transit's STAR paratransit service by month. A completed trip is the total number of STAR trips booked where passengers was successfully picked up and dropped off. This metric illustrates the total volume of STAR trips, which may have one or more riders. Select one or more calendar years to explore STAR Trips Completed overtime. This data is sourced from the STAR service providers.

STAR OTP Trends

1. Jan, Feb, and March 2024 OTP averages 92%, compared to 90% OTP in 2023 for the same period



This graph depicts On-Time Performance (OTP) of Arlington Transit's paratransit service STAR, as a percentage, by month. STAR On-Time Performance is the percentage of trips that reach a pick up location on-time. On-time is within 10 minutes of the pick up window. This metric illustrates the reliability of the para transit service and the operational efficiency of STAR. Select one or more calendar years to explore ART's On-Time Performance over time. This data is sourced from the service provider who is responsible for tracking and reporting service performance metrics.
