Coming Soon: Frequently Asked Questions

- **SPRC Consensus**: Not necessarily ideas that VHC can accommodate or support
- Greater setbacks
 - More concern about relationship between VHC and buildings across the street (separation/distance)
 - Less concern about “street presence” or relationship with the streetscape
- Building height and tapering
 - Generally want reduced height and more gradual tapering
 - Less of a priority than setbacks

Areas of SPRC Consensus

- Initial plans are too imposing and create a wall around the hospital campus
- Outpatient Pavilion
 - Locate more interior to the site
 - Closer to 1715 Medical Office Building
- Parking garage
 - Reduce visibility
 - Maximize parking underground (larger footprint and/or more levels)



- As design evolves, need more views of the proposal
 - What will it look like from a neighbor's front door or window?
- Support for future phases that would create an internal ring road
- Pedestrian connections
 - More pleasant, safe, and accessible paths within and through the site

Further Discussion Needed

- Should the site configuration be more open to the community?
 - Community feels invited to take a walk, enjoy plazas/open spaces, get a cup of coffee
- Should the site configuration be more separated from the neighborhood?
 - More buffers, dense landscaping
- Is there a way to accomplish both?



- Architecture
 - Façade design: windows, solid walls, materials
 - Relationship of building frontage to street
 - Adding bays or bumpouts to create rhythm along streetscape?
 - Brick vs. glass in prominent areas
