


  - Accessory structure for combined sales and rental use by High Adventure Course and batting cages to replace existing ticket booth
  - Outdoor seating area
  - Parking lot improvements (91 additional spaces with 8 accessible spaces)


High Adventure Course

- Lower Park Area Proposed Improvements
  - New Playground w/ seating areas
  - Restroom building renovations
  - Paved and natural surface trails
  - VDOT approved entrance at Wilson Blvd & N Lebanon St
  - Parking lot (25 spaces with 1 accessible space)
  - Park signage
  - Picnic shelter

- NOVA Parks goal to minimize impacts to existing trees and plant communities
- Tree Survey is currently being prepared by ISA Certified Arborist
- Adjustments to the proposed layout will be made to avoid as many native trees as possible
- Tree replacement will be performed as required per Arlington County Landscape Standards "Replacement Guidelines"
